DAY 7: FAIRMONT CHATEAU LAURIER

Journey to Canada's beautiful capital city of Ottawa. En route, enjoy a guided tour at Fromagerie St-Albert to watch master cheesemakers craft award-winning curds, while learning the rich history. Taste the cheese curds on their signature Poutine dish before continuing to one of Canada's largest and most popular cultural institutions, The Canadian Museum of History. Savor award-winning farm to table cuisine before settling in for a 2-night stay at the 5-star Fairmont Château Laurier. **B, D**

DAY 8: SHOWCASING OTTAWA/TULIP FESTIVAL

Board Canada's Niagara City Cruises boat for a cruise past American Falls, Bridal Veil Falls, and into the very heart of Horseshoe Falls for an exhilarating up-close encounter with the famous natural wonder, Niagara Falls. This afternoon, say au revoir from Toronto and “merci” for a trip filled with extraordinary memories! **B**
