### DAY 4: LONGWOOD GARDENS/HAGLEY MUSEUM

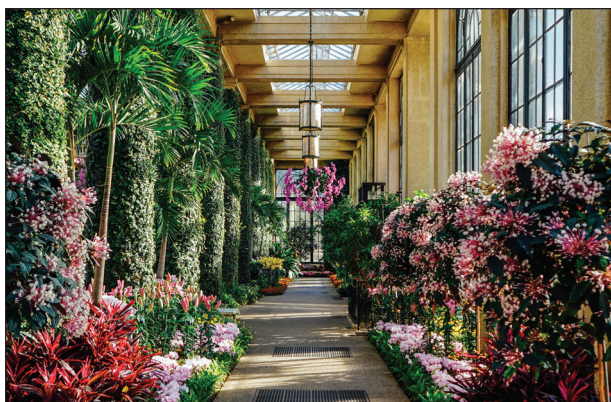
