Iceland’s breathtaking landscapes unfold with impressive waterfalls, black sand beaches, and steaming geothermal pools, creating the perfect setting for an unforgettable adventure on this unique itinerary. While circumnavigating the whole island on the “Ring Road”, soak in the mineral-rich waters of Mývatn Nature Baths, watch the sun glisten off the icebergs at Diamond Beach, and spot whales swimming in the wild. Every moment offers a chance to explore, discover, and take in Iceland’s natural beauty.

DAYS 1-2: WELCOME TO ICELAND!

After an overnight flight, begin your Icelandic adventure in Reykjavík, the charming capital, home to over 140,000 proud Viking descendants. Explore its colorful streets on a guided walking tour before experiencing the Icelandic Lava Show—the only place in the world to witness real molten lava up close. Tonight, we’ll gather for a Welcome Dinner. *D*

DAY 3: FRÍÐHEIMAR/THE GOLDEN CIRCLE

Start the day at Þingvellir National Park, a site with immense historical and geological significance. At Friðheimar, discover a unique geothermal greenhouse where tomatoes thrive year-round, and learn about Iceland’s innovative farming techniques. Visit the stables to meet Icelandic horses, known for their unique gaits and gentle nature demonstrated live in a horse show. Continue to the Geysir Geothermal Area, a highlight of the Golden Circle and Gullfoss Waterfall, before enjoying dinner together. *B, D*



DAY 4: WATERFALLS/SKÓGAR FOLK MUSEUM/BLACK SAND BEACH

Marvel at two breathtaking waterfalls—Seljalandsfoss, where a path leads behind the cascading water, and Skógafoss, one of Iceland's largest, plunging 60 meters into a misty pool below. Explore Skógar Folk Museum, showcasing Iceland's cultural heritage with artifacts, historical exhibits, and folklore displays. End the day at Reynisfjara, a striking black sand beach with dramatic basalt columns and roaring waves. **B, D**



Embark on a whale-watching excursion in Hauganes

DAY 5: JÖKULSÁRLÓN GLACIER LAGOON/BOAT TOUR/DIAMOND BEACH

Journey to Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon, where icebergs break off from Breiðamerkurjökull Glacier and drift toward the sea. Experience an unforgettable Amphibian Boat Tour, gliding past shimmering icebergs. Then, visit Diamond Beach, where translucent ice formations contrast beautifully against the black volcanic sand. Continue to Egilsstaðir for dinner. **B, D**

DAY 6: DETTIFOSS/KRAFLA/NÁMASKARÐ

Stand in awe at Dettifoss, Europe's most powerful waterfall, where torrents of water crash over a 45-meter drop. Explore the volcanic landscapes of Krafla, home to the vivid Víti crater, before visiting Námaskarð, a geothermal area of bubbling mud pools and steaming fumaroles. Finally, transfer to Akureyri, the "Capital of the North," Iceland's second largest city. **B, D**

DAY 7: WATERFALLS/LAVA FORMATIONS/GEOTHERMAL BATH

Visit Goðafoss, the "Waterfall of the Gods," spanning 30 meters across a dramatic cliff. Discover Dimmuborgir, or "The Dark Castles," a surreal lava field formed by an ancient eruption. In Skútustaðir, view the crater formations of Hverfjall before unwinding at Mývatn Nature Baths. Enjoy a soak in its warm, mineral-rich waters while admiring Iceland's volcanic beauty. **B, L**

DAY 8: WHALE WATCHING/AKUREYRI

Embark on a whale-watching excursion in Hauganes. Don't forget your camera for the incomparable views of Eyjafjörður, Iceland's oldest whale-watching hub, where sightings of humpback and minke whales are common. Enjoy hot chocolate and cinnamon buns on board the boat, before continuing southeast through green pastures, stunning fjord landscapes to the quaint village of Laugarbakki. **B, D**

DAY 9: CRATER/HOT SPRINGS/HORSE FARM

Start the day by visiting Grábrók Crater, formed over 3,400 years ago, for panoramic lava field views. Continue to Deildartunguhver, one of Europe's most powerful hot springs, then admire the stunning cascades of Hraunfossar and Barnafoss. At Sturlureykir Horse Farm in Reykholt, meet Icelandic horses and sample fresh rye bread baked using geothermal heat. **B, D**

DAY 10: RETURN HOME

Transfer to Keflavík airport returning home with memories of Iceland's breathtaking landscapes. **B** 🇮🇸
